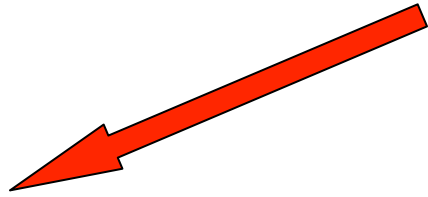




Rainbows seem to appear in the sky when sun and rain are both right. This acrostic poem tells of the 7 colours that together make up visible light.*
